

Fast Facts

- If you need anything during our summer events, please call Kathy at 937-537-1810. She will always carry her cell phone with her. If you cannot reach her for some reason, call Carrie at 937-578-8669. If you can't reach her, call the church at 642-4712 and they will locate one of them for you.
- Don't forget to pack a lunch for the afternoon events at the church and to wear appropriate clothing for our events!
- In case of rain, all outdoor events will be moved to the church gym.
- If you are able to chaperone for any of these events, please contact Kathy and let her know! We would love to have your help in order to make these events a success!
- We ask that girls wear modest clothing including no short shorts or low-cut tops. Also, one piece bathing suits/tankinis are preferred for our water events. Guys are asked not to wear muscle shirts or shorts where underwear can be seen. Shirts should be worn at all times during non-water activities.

These expectations are in place for all participants within the youth ministry of Marysville FUMC:

FUMC:

- Be and active listener (to the ONE person that is talking) and pay attention to them
- Be respectful (give appropriate answers, be kind, face the person talking, think before you act, be responsible, raise your hand quietly when you know the answer)
- Be a leader not a follower
- Face the leader when she is talking and do not goof around
- Do what you are told to do (participate)
- Think before you act.
- If any cell phones are seen during our program they will be confiscated and parents must retrieve them after our event.
- Students must travel in groups of three and may not go beyond the boundaries set for any given event
- If a student goes reaches the third strike after they have already been removed in the past, a meeting between Kathy, the parents, and the student must happen before they can return to Outbreak.
- Excessive rough play or refusal to listen to adults will result in an immediate Strike 3.

Strike 1: Removal from games, and separation from friends for duration of the event (If students refuse to obey this instruction, their parents will be immediately called and they will not be able to participate the following week).

Strike 2: Call parents for conversation about what we can all do to prevent this behavior again

Strike 3: Removal from program for the following week
